



Fire safety checklist for a worry-free christmas holiday



Choose the right tree

Opt for a tree with roots and a damp root ball. Avoid trees that are already losing their needles.

Water it regularly to keep the roots moist; a dry tree is an immediate fire hazard.

If choosing a synthetic tree, prioritize one rated as fire-retardant or flame-resistant.



Placement and security

Install your tree securely in a low-traffic area, away from doorways. Keep it at a safe distance from curtains to ensure both stability and safety.



Decorations

Many decorations are flammable. Choose items labeled as flame-resistant or non-combustible.



String lights

Use only high-quality electric lights. They generate heat and can potentially ignite the tree if they are faulty.

As a safety precaution, always turn off all decorative lights whenever you leave the room.



Candles

Never use real candles on or near the Christmas tree.
